Dormouse

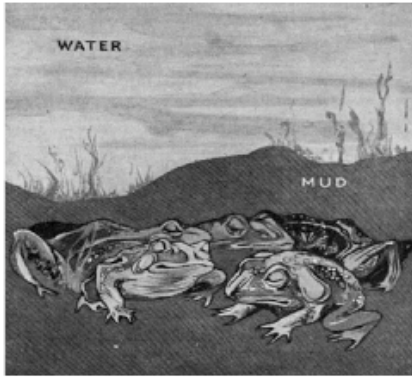
I hibernate on the ground, rolled tightly into a ball in a nest of leaves and grass.
